

# Summer Reading Program

## Guidelines:

1. Registration begins Monday, June 4. Sign up anytime during the summer and get your reading log.
2. Check out books from the Macomb Public Library and read them at home!
3. Reading Requirements:
  - Pre-Readers: Read 30 books with help and record the titles on your reading log. Recommended for children birth to 6 years old.
  - Readers: Read 1000 minutes over the summer and mark your time on your reading log. That's about 20 minutes a day! Recommended for children ages 7 to 13 years old.
4. When your reading requirements are met, bring in your book log and receive:
  - A certificate of achievement
  - A complimentary book
  - A Macomb Public Library water bottle
  - A McDonalds Happy Meal Coupon
  - A ticket voucher for the Peoria Chiefs or Peoria Rivermen
  - Invitation to our Sunday Funday Party, Sunday, July 29 from 12:00 - 2:00 pm at Ball Fore
5. Summer Reading ends on Friday, July 27!!

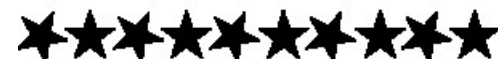


## Sunday Fun Day at Ball Fore

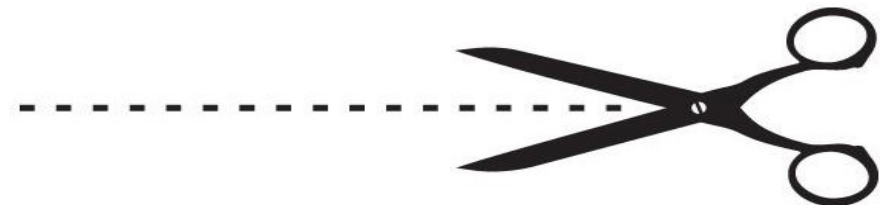
